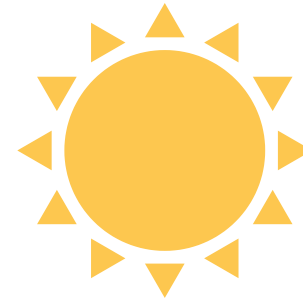

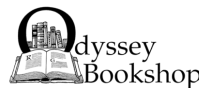


How to play:
